Do you qualify for Commodities?

Eligible persons, 60 yrs. & over, must be able to provide proof of age, such as; a current Nebraska ID, passport, or green card. There is also a CFSP income guideline that may change every year, so

CSFP clients are required to provide income documentation at the time of certification and re-certification, such as; a Social Security Statement, retirement payments, a bank statement, or pay stubs for one month.



What is a CSFP food package?

A CSFP food package contains: USDA milk, canned meats, canned vegetables, canned fruit, dry beans or peanut butter, cereal, pasta, & cheese.

What is a Proxy?

A proxy is a person who may act on your behalf, in the event that you cannot make scheduled appointments, and you can name as many proxies as you like. A proxy form is completed annually and kept in the CSFP clients file.
